## Overview of the Orange County Wine Society

The Orange County Wine Society, Inc., is a non-profit corporation whose purpose is to promote the knowledge and understanding of wine. To this end, the Society functions to enhance the knowledge of winemaking, viticulture and the appreciation of wine. The Society acts as the co-sponsor and is the main support group for the Orange County Fair's world-famous Commercial Wine Competition and the Homewine Competition. During the Fair, the Orange County Wine Society proudly exhibits the award-winning wines and features the wines for tasting to the public at The Courtyard in the Orange County Fairgrounds.

The OCWS has two major fundraisers during the year. The Wine Classic, held in the summer, is designed to permit a large number of wineries to present their wines that won medals at the Orange County Fair. The Wine Extraordinaire, held in late February or early March, features those wineries with limited production and creates the opportunity for them to reach the wine enthusiast in Southern California.

Formed in 1976, the OCWS is a fully qualified, tax-exempt educational organization. The Society annually provides scholarships to deserving students of Enology at the University of California, Davis, students of Viticulture at California State University, Fresno, and to students in related fields at other colleges and universities.

Monthly meetings are held on the second Friday of each month at 7:30 p.m. Many special events, special wine dinners and tastings for OCWS members and their guests, and even wine cruises are announced periodically. Your membership in the Orange County Wine Society entitles you to attend our functions. At our scheduled monthly meetings, our guest speakers are usually winemakers who present their wines with an emphasis on sensory evaluation, microclimatic and regional variations, style and other educational aspects of wine and winemaking. Our membership programs, especially those devoted to wine education, are offered to members "at cost".

The OCWS conducts all of its activities and operations through the volunteer efforts of its members. As a member in good standing, you will have the opportunity to assist in the planning, organization, production, staging and operation of major publicized wine events in California. At the same time, whether you are a wine "novice" or an extremely knowledgeable "connoisseur", your participation will contribute to the education of wine to members of the public while enhancing your own expertise.

Many of our members are home winemakers. Their wines are routinely entered in the Orange County Fair Homewine Competition where they compete for coveted medals. As Society members, you will have the opportunity to sample the creations of your fellow members.

As you might expect, wine is served and consumed at our meetings and events. Moderation is expected and required from all of our members. If you want to have a good time and learn about wine, especially California wines and the California Wine Industry, we welcome your application.
